Opens: July 1st - The RCG application opens July 1st of each year but is not accessible until the previous year's annual report is filed. This has been filed and officially accepted.

Closes: September 1st - The RCG application closes.

The grant is competitive and requires a local match based on population. Applications are evaluated on project quality, budget, goals, outcomes, and demonstrated economic need and are up to \$600,000.

Application window:

Opens: September 15, 2025 (mid-September)

Closes: October 31, 2025 (closes 6 weeks after it opens)
