If there are other outstanding bonds, an otherwise scheduled tax decrease may not occur if these bonds are issued. The foregoing information is only an estimate and is not a limit on the amount of taxes that the District may be required to levy to pay debt service on the Bonds. The District is obligated to levy taxes to the extent provided by law in order to pay the Bonds.</p>
